Costs and Registration: The cost per week is **\$200** (unless you are a first time camper). A **NON-REFUNDABLE** deposit of **\$50** must be sent with your registration form. One half of the camper fee is refundable up to 2 weeks before camp opens. If less than 2 weeks before camp, no refunds or transfers are possible. Please note if a church is paying for a portion of the registration, it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure payment is made.

First Time Camper Discount: If you have never been to Camp Carmel before, this is the time. All first time campers can attend at a reduced rate of **\$150**. That is **\$50 off!!** Churches, please inform your congregations of this. Also, please continue your support of Camp Carmel to enable us to continue this offer in the future. We operate with one purpose: spreading the love of Christ. We can only do that if we have campers in the cabins. **Make checks payable to: Camp Carmel**

Dress Code: Keep the following in mind when packing:

- No shirts with questionable print are permitted. (i.e. alcohol, cigarettes, suggestive wording, profanity, etc.)
- Girls, if wearing a two-piece bathing suit, a t-shirt must also be worn, at all times.
- No short-shorts are to be worn.

Camp staff reserves the right to determine what is appropriate and inappropriate (i.e. spaghetti straps, tank tops, etc.)

Information for Parents:

- Registration is from **3:30 to 5:30pm.** Note that all weeks begin on Sunday
- Saturday Pick Up is at **9:00am.**

- Emails to your camper may be sent to **info@campcarmel.com**. Please put the camper's name in the subject line.
- **SCHOLARSHIP MONEY IS AVAILABLE!!** As always, there is scholarship money available for those young people who need a sponsor to attend camp. Contact Chris Carson for more information.
- Our cost per camper for a week of camp is about \$300. We attempt to keep registration fees within reach of the campers in our area. Therefore, the price again this year is only \$200 for all campers. This is made possible by the financial support of our local churches. Contributions are welcomed and appreciated!
- You will be able to place money on the Camp Store Account for your child when you register at the camp. Any money leftover will be refunded to the child at the end of the week. The store sells candy, pop, snacks, and Camp Carmel items including T-shirts.

What to Bring:

- Study Materials (Bible, notebooks, and pencils)
- Hiking boots, Extra pairs of shoes, and Water shoes (shoes that you can get wet & stay on your feet. Flip-flops are not acceptable water shoes.
- Bedding (sheets, pillow, sleeping bag, blankets)
- Labeled clothing (including some for cool weather and rain)
- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Flashlight and batteries
- Bathing suit
- Several towels and washcloths
- Ball glove
- Camera
- A backpack and water bottle for bike trips and hikes
- Money for a Camp Store Account
- Bike (helmet required if 12 or under)

Directions: Take 119 North from Uniontown or South from Connellsville to the Fayette County Fairgrounds. Turn onto Pechin Road (Right if coming from Uniontown; Left if coming from Connellsville). Go about 1 mile, as you pass a cemetery on the left, turn left. Go straight through 2 stop signs. Stay on this road, which bears to the right at Stefanoe's Printing, until you come to Kingan Hill Road. Turn left onto Kingan Hill Road (this eventually becomes Liston Road). Go about 2.5 miles and bear right at the bottom of the first steep hill. Go about 1 mile to the second steep hill. Follow it to the bottom and turn left onto the bike trail.

Note: there is a gate at the bike trail. If you arrive at camp at times other than drop-off/pick-up times the gate will be locked. In this case, you will need to walk into camp (about 100 yards) and ask a staff person to unlock the gate for you.

What NOT to Bring: Bad attitudes, magazines, food (it attracts unwanted "guests") MP3 players, electronic games, and cellular phones. (These items will be secured by the camp staff upon arrival and returned to the camper at the end of their week. They disrupt the camping experience.) **This is strictly enforced.**
